Federally mandated airbag warning and suffocation risk

Not approved or fake



Basic warning label with little information



Seat has chest clip and five point harness with hip straps



No chest clip and no hip straps



**Lots of info (including Wt & Ht limits)
federal wording for use in vehicles,
additional sticker for manufacturer
contact, date seat was made, and model #**



Limited information, stickers may or may not be present, no manufacturer or model information

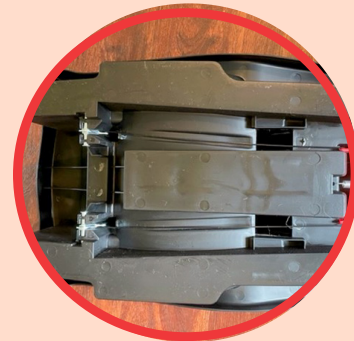


Labels on the car seat base

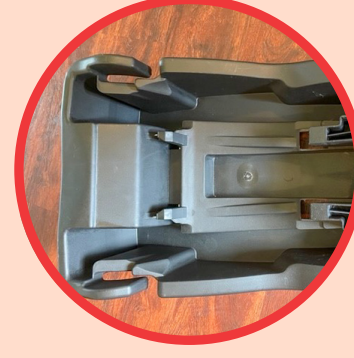


Federally required lower anchors

No labels

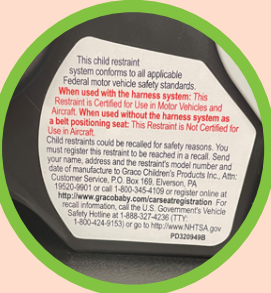


No lower anchors, flimsy base release lever, base may not be included

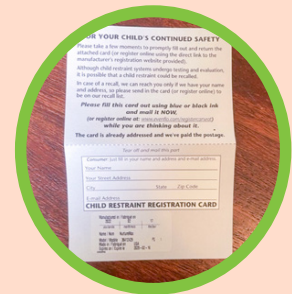
Other federal requirements:



Textile tag on the car seat



Label: "This child restraint system conforms to all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards."



Recall card that has manufacturer information and is ready to mail
